Volunteer Liability Waiver:

In order for volunteers with the Larimer County Department of Natural Resources (hereinafter the County) to understand the nature of the work and duties expected of Overland Mountain Bike Club.

Description of the County's Expectations:

Volunteers are expected to comply with all park and open spaces safety regulations while performing agreed upon duties. Volunteers must take responsibility for their own safety and the safety of others whilst representing the County.

The County will provide the volunteer with necessary training and supervision as well as waive any park or open spaces fees while the volunteer is on duty.

Nature of Relationship:

The volunteer is not an employee of the County nor is the volunteer compensated in any manner. The volunteer is not in the service of the County nor is the volunteer under any contract of hire with the County either expressly or implied. The volunteer is also not an appointee of the County. Nothing stated in this document shall create a contract of employment or otherwise. In addition, this document shall not be construed to create any relationship of agent, servant, employee, partner, or joint venture between the volunteer and the County.

Insurance (Including Liability):

THE VOLUNTEER or VOLUNTEER GROUP ARE NOT ENTITLED TO WORKERS COMPENSATION BENEFITS. The volunteer and volunteer group shall be responsible for providing all his/her insurance for personal injury or property damage suffered by the volunteer in the performance of his/her volunteer duties.

The County will protect the volunteer from liability for injury or damages sustained by another, that is, the County will assume the costs of defense for claims brought against the volunteer, and will pay judgments and settlements of claims, provided the volunteer was acting within the scope of his/her volunteer duties, was not willful or wanton in his/her conduct, does not settle or compromise any claims brought against him/her without the consent of the County, has not willfully or knowingly failed to notify the County of the incident or occurrence causing the claim, and notifies the County of any suit within 15 days after the commencement of the action.
