Trails

Been in contact with Megan (County) and she has given the committee a show/tell of open space master plan. Pam Mayhew and Joel Schwab (volunteer coordinators) to discuss ideas for Hidden Valley connector trail. First trail day in April will be a large trail-building event all-hands-on-deck volunteer trail building event. Opportunity for Crew Leader Training Event. This is an Overland-specific event. Planning additional trail dates for Hermit Park. 20th Anniversary party of the adoption of Open Spaces Taxes.

County has requested \$5k grant from Overland for the Hidden Valley trail project. 1.5 miles of trail and a parking lot re-do. Board vote approves \$3k grant and volunteer hours. Kenny and Mick to discuss offer with county their needs and Overland recognition.

Meeting with FC Natural Areas: discussion on their trail needs. Invited Overland Trails Committee to start exploring alt line options at Reservoir Ridge, and this is still an open-ended conversation. Potential to keep trail building opens for Monday evenings throughout the summer of small crews getting specific sections done at a time. They're discussing a reroute for Maxwell and planning for starting that process.
