

September 27, 2018 Patrol Committee Meeting Minutes

6:00-7:00 pm @ Old Town Public Library

Members Present: Sue Dukart (Patrol Director), Kenny Bearden, Mick Syzek, Thuan Nguyen, Paul Slaughter, Pete Skram, Travis Web, Hal Hansen, John Byers, and Aggie Holer.

Topics of Discussion;

- 1) Final T or C details; Saturday 9/29 - Patrol / First Aid Tent coverage 8-4 pm by Sue Dukart. She will bring first aid supplies, tent will be brought in trailer with rest of supplies.

Sunday 9/30 patrol coverage - each stage covered with at least two patrollers for pre-ride then sweep. All stages covered at this point. Pete will be the Patrol lead based at the command tent at Soldier Canyon Parking Lot. Each patroller is asked to arrive early enough to ride out to their starting position prior to the scheduled time.

- 2) Patrol Documentation; Pete Skram has finally been successful at arranging a meeting with Pam Mayhew, Rhonda Peckham, Charlotte Norville and Lindsey (Offero IT person) to discuss a new documentation system for DPMBP that is compatible with the Cities and Counties system. The meeting is scheduled for Wednesday 10/17/18 @ 1:30. More details to follow after the meeting. Sue, Pete and possibly Kenny will attend this meeting.

- 3) End of season group ride; Mick Syzek has offered to arrange for the patrol group to ride the new and improved Youngs Gulch Trail on Sunday 10/21/18 - we will meet at the North King Soopers at 9 am to carpool up or be at the trailhead by 10 am to ride. After party will be at the Mish for food and drinks. Sue will check into what budget is available to recognize the top 10 patrol volunteers. This will include patrol events in addition to patrol logs.

- 4) October Patrol Meeting (4th Thursday of the Month) falls on the club season finale party so the October patrol meeting will be pushed back into November (date TBD- since the 4th Thursday in November is Thanksgiving). Future meetings will be opened up to the entire patrol group to get more interest/ input and help with planning of events.

Off season topics of discussion will include ordering new patrol Jerseys, Updating/ better defining the Patrol objective, perhaps moving toward a trails steward/

agent type arrangement, recruiting new patrollers, getting more volunteer participation, and better communication between the Board, and sub committees.

5) Off season happenings for Patrol

- watch for announcements regarding a Bike Maintenance / on the trail repairs/ fixes to get you home safely- offered by John Byers Bike mechanic at Peloton and one of our own DPMBP new patrollers this season.

- patrol/ trail agent training with Mick.

- Notification of patrol training status to keep patrollers up to date on all required trainings.
